#### AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA

(Calvary Baptist Church / 2106 E. Windsor Road)

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Philo Fire Protection District, and includes certain territory within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of said Fire Protection District, the Board of Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on June 7, 2001, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 p.m., Monday, July 2, 2001, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, on the 8th day of June, 2001; and

WHEREAS, there are no electors residing within such territory; and
WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 2001-05-047 on June 4,
2001 approving and authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed by this Ordinance is presently located within Champaign County's AG-2, Agriculture zoning district and upon annexation will be classified R-4, Medium Density Multiple Family Residential upon annexation in accordance with the above-referenced annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said petition complies with all requirements of the law therefore; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

The West Four Hundred Forty and Eight-six Hundredths (440.86) feet of the South Four Hundred Ninety-four and Four Hundredths (494.04) feet of the West Half (W ½) of the Southwest Quarter (SW ¼) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Champaign County, Illinois.

As per survey recorded in Plat Book "X" at page 216 as Document No. 73R6917 in the records of Champaign County, Illinois.

Containing 5.00 acres, more or less, all situated in Urbana Township, Champaign County, Illinois.

Together with the adjacent unincorporated public Rights-of-Way, which are by operation of the law automatically annexed with the adoption of an Annexation Ordinance pertaining to this parcel, described as follows:

That portion of Windsor Road Right-of-Way, which lies adjacent to the above described tract. Said Right-of-Way contains 0.66 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

commonly known for reference as <u>2106 E. Windsor Road</u>, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois. The above-described parcel, prior to annexation, has the parcel index number <u>30-21-22-</u> and following annexation the said parcel should bear the parcel index number 93-21-22-300-002.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Recorder's Office of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file, for record, a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the County Clerk and County Election Authority of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 4. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to classify the real property herein annexed as R-4, Medium Density Multiple Family Residential upon annexation and in accordance with Ordinance No. 2001-05-047 passed by the Urbana City Council on June 4, 2001, approving and authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement for said territory.

Section 5. The territory annexed herein is assigned to City of Urbana Ward 6.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect at 12:00 p.m. CDT, July 12, 2001.

## EASEMENT (ELECTRIC)

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH, its successors and assigns hereinafter referred to as Grantor, whether one or more and whether an individual, individuals, corporation or other legal entity, for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100<sup>ths</sup> Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto ILLINOIS POWER COMPANY, d/b/a AmerenIP, an Illinois corporation, its successors, assigns, licensees, agents, lessees, contractors, Sub-contractors and tenants (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee"), the perpetual right and easement to construct, reconstruct, use, operate, maintain, add to the number of and patrol an electric and communication line or lines consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, conduits, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto, including transformers, on, over, across, or under the following described land, in Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 9 East, 3rd P.M., Champaign County, Illinois, to-wit:

A portion of the West 440.86 feet of the South 494.04 feet of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, as per survey recorded in Plat Book "X" at page 216 as Document 73R 6917, in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 22, thence, N 01°18'55" W, along the west line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of 53.88 feet, to the existing northerly Right-of-Way line of Windsor Road, said point being the Point of Beginning; thence, continuing N 01°18'55" W, along said west line, a distance of 21.12 feet; thence, N 89°16'29" E, along a line parallel with and 75.00 feet northerly of the south line of said Southwest Quarter, a distance of 440.86 feet, to the east line of the West 440.86 feet of the South 494.04 feet of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 22; thence, S 01°18'55" E, along said east line, a distance of 25.00 feet, to the northerly Right-of-Way line of Windsor Road; thence, S 89°16'29" W, along said northerly Right-of-Way line, a distance of 25.20 feet; thence, S 89°16'31" W, continuing along said northerly Right-of-Way line, a distance of 22.62 feet, to the Point of Beginning.

together with all rights reasonably implied by and incidental to the exercise and enjoyment of said easement rights, including without limitation the right of ingress and egress to and over the above described easement area and premises of Grantor adjoining the same, for all purposes herein stated; together with the right to remove at any time and from time to time, any and all brush, bushes, trees, roots undergrowth, rock or other obstructions upon, over or under the surface of said easement area and of the premises of Grantor adjoining the same deemed by Grantee to interfere with the construction, maintenance or use of, or endanger the safety of, said line or lines; and the right to license, permit or otherwise agree to the use or occupancy of said line or lines by any other person, association or corporation for electric and communication purposes; and with the further right to remove at any time any or all of the said line or lines, and appurtenances thereto erected upon, over or under said land by virtue hereof.

Grantee shall be responsible for actual damages occurring on the herein described property as a result of the construction, operation, maintenance or repair of Grantee's facilities and shall reimburse the owner thereof for such loss or damages.

Grantor, for itself, its successors and assigns, does hereby warrant and covenant unto Grantee (1) that it is the owner of the above described land and has full right and authority validly to grant this easement, (2) that Grantee may quietly enjoy the premises for the purposes herein stated, and (3) that Grantor will not create or permit any building or other obstruction of any kind or character that will interfere with the Grantee's exercise and enjoyment of the easement rights hereinabove conveyed.
