

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PARKING METERS

WHEREAS, the University of Illinois, the City of Champaign, and the City of Urbana, have entered into an agreement to create a "University District" to more efficiently accommodate vehicular traffic and parking and pedestrian movement; and

WHEREAS, one aspect of the University District plan calls for uniformity in parking regulations, operation and meter rates; and

WHEREAS, to insure that all parking meters within the University District are similar in operation and appearance, it is desirable that the purchase of such meters be from the same supplier.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows: that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to contract for the purchase of parking meters without the necessity of first seeking competitive bids, provided such contract does not exceed the total amount of \$210,000.00 for all such meters.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by two-thirds (2/3rd's) vote of the Alderpersons then holding office at a special meeting of said Council.
