

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 23-172 OF ARTICLE VIII OF THE
URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE CLARIFYING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
LOADING ZONES IN SPECIFIED PLACES ON CERTAIN STREETS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Article VIII, Section 23-172 of the URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE is amended, as follows:

"No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose in any place marked as a curb loading zone during hours when the regulations applicable to such curb loading zones are in effect, except that stopping, standing, or parking may occur in a curb loading zone for the expeditious loading or unloading of passengers, goods, supplies, or deliveries, but then only for a period not to exceed the posted period of time. During hours when the regulations applicable to such curb loading zones are not in effect, stopping, standing or parking may occur as otherwise permitted."

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance

shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
