# An Ordinance Annexing Certain Territory To The City Of Urbana

(Approximately 0.72 Acres on a Tract Located on the North Side of Willow View Road, Approximately 200 Feet East of Cunningham Avenue)

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois and includes certain territory within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the Carroll Fire Protection District, the Board of Urbana Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on Tuesday, April 13, 2004, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 p.m., Monday, May 3, 2004, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, on the 21st day of April, 2004; and

WHEREAS, a written petition signed by the Owners of Record has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 2004-030-027 on March 8, 2004 approving and authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed by this Ordinance is presently located within Champaign County's B-4, General Business zoning district and upon annexation the tract will be classified B-3, General Business in accordance with the above-referenced annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said petition complies with all requirements of the law therefore; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz.:

### Dog Club Site:

All that part of the East half of the South half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 4, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, lying South and East of that portion thereof acquired by the Department of Public Works and Buildings of the State of Illinois for the construction of Federal Aid Interstate Highway No. 74, as shown by an order entered in the Circuit Court of Champaign County, Illinois, on June 28, 1956 in Common Law Case No. 20942 and appearing in Circuit Court Record 77 at page 47, except the South 16 feet thereof, situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory herein above described in the Recorder's Office of Champaign County, Illinois in the Office of the County Clerk and County Election Authority of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 4. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to classify the real property herein annexed as B-3, General Business upon annexation and in accordance with an annexation agreement approved and authorized on March 8, 2004 by Council Ordinance No. 2004-03-027.

Section 5. The territory annexed herein is assigned to City of Urbana Ward 5.

Section 6. To avoid uncertainty regarding public safety responsibilities concerning the property herein annexed, this Ordinance shall take effect at noon on the  $4^{\rm th}$  day of May 2004 following its passage by the Urbana City Council.


