

**AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY AUTHORIZING PARKING  
ON A STREET LISTED ON SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183  
OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING  
AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS**

(Florida Avenue)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following street is listed on Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code; however, because of circumstances of that road not presently being a through road and consequently has low traffic volumes that parking shall be temporarily permitted, except as listed below, on that road until two years hence or until made a through street whichever comes sooner:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>
Florida Avenue	From 92' west of Smith Road to 98' east of Smith Road	North Side
Florida Avenue	From 92' west of Ogelthorpe Avenue to 98' east of Ogelthorpe Avenue	North Side
Florida Avenue	From 92' west of Montgomery Street to 98' east of Montgomery Street	North Side
Florida Avenue	From 92' west of Abercorn Street to 98' east of Abercorn Street	North Side

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Florida Avenue	From 92' west of Abercorn Street to 98' east of Abercorn Street	North Side

Section 3. 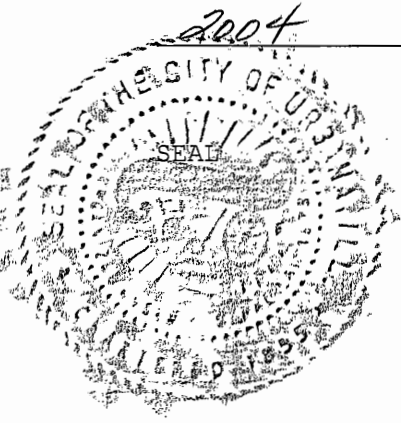
