

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-27 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE  
(Rules for Deliberations)**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that:

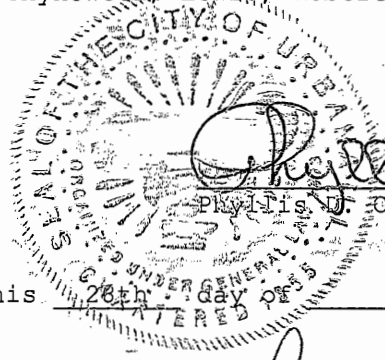
Section 1. Section 2-27 of the Urbana City Code entitled "Rules for Deliberations", subparagraph (4) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(4) At any meeting of the city council, upon the making of and second to a motion (whether phrased as a "motion to defer" or otherwise), the effect of which would be to postpone consideration of any agenda item to the next regular meeting of the council, which such agenda item is then before the city council for the first time by motion made and seconded, any such agenda item shall be automatically deferred for final action thereon to the next regular meeting of the city council, unless upon the making of and second to a subsequent motion, three-fourths of those aldermen/alderwomen present vote to consider such deferred item at a special meeting to be called and held before the date of the next regular meeting."

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a meeting of said Council.
