AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE N OF SECTION 23-193 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE LIMITING PARKING TIME ON CERTAIN STREETS OR PUBLIC PARKING LOTS

(An Area Bounded by Beslin Street, Goodwin Avenue, Wright Street, Church Street and the Norfolk Southern Railroad Tracks)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule N of Section 23-193, entitled "Parking Time Limits Pursuant to Section 23-193", of Article VIII of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following streets where no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time in excess of that indicated between the hours specified below on the designated days and times:

Mathews Avenue from Church Street to Beslin Street	West	Monday through Friday	9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.	2 Hours
Romine Street from Church Street to Beslin Street	East	Monday through Friday	9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.	2 Hours

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
