

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A  
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF  
COMMERCE BUREAU OF THE CENSUS FOR A PARTIAL SPECIAL CENSUS**

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois has experienced significant, measurable population growth since the 2000 Census; and

WHEREAS, officially tabulating that growth through the partial special census process will result in additional revenue for the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the people of Urbana to execute the Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Department of Commerce Bureau of the Census for a partial special census.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves and authorizes the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Department of Commerce Bureau of the Census for a partial special census.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest the said Memorandum of Understanding.

Section 3. This Ordinance takes effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.


This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a meeting of the Council.


