ORDINANCE NO. 2008-05-039

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FOURTEEN OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, ADDING CLASS R-RESTAURANT LIQUOR LICENSE, TO THE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHANGING THE FEE FOR CATERER'S RETAIL-ADDITIONAL SITE

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has heretofore adopted a Schedule of Fees for the fiscal year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that the best interests of the City are served by amending said ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Chapter 14, "Licenses and Permits," Section 14-7, "Schedule of Fees," Subsection A(1) Alcoholic Liquor Licenses, is hereby amended as follows:

Add Subsection(r), Class R (restaurant drink/package-consumption on or off premises).....\$3,962

Amend Subsection (i), Class CA1-Caterer's Retail - Additional Site (consumption at catering location only)....\$350

Section 2. Those sections, paragraphs, and provisions of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, that are not expressly amended or repealed by this Ordinance are hereby re-enacted, and it is expressly declared to be the intention of this Ordinance not to repeal or amend any portions of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, other than those expressly set forth as amended or repealed in this Ordinance. The invalidity of any section or provision of this Ordinance hereby passed and approved shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability

incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a meeting of said Council.
