

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-10-116

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE
AND THE SCHEDULE OF FINES PURSUANT SECTION 1-10(j)
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE**

(Increasing Meter, Restricted, Prohibited Fines)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the attached "Schedule of Fines" is hereby approved and shall remain in effect until a new schedule is approved pursuant to the procedures adopted in Ordinance No. 1999-01-003.

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed. In addition, the below language replaces or removes the sections so noted:

**ARTICLE XIV
STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING RESTRICTED
OR PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS**

Sec. 23-193. Parking time limited on certain streets or public parking lots.

Subsection (c) deleted

**ARTICLE XVI.
PARKING VIOLATION PROCEDURES AND PENALTIES**

Sec. 23-211. Parking violation procedures.

(2) Payment of a ticket for a parking violation at any time is a final determination of liability.

c. Any person who violates any provision of Articles XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVII, XVIII, XIX and XX, of this traffic code, excluding those sections for which specific penalties are provided, may, within seven (7) days of the time when the notice required in section 23-211(a)(1) of this traffic code was attached to the vehicle, settle as the penalty therefor and in full satisfaction therefor the sum set forth for such period in the schedule of fines established pursuant to section 1-10(j) of the Code of

Ordinances or, after seven (7) days, in like manner the sum set forth for such period in the schedule of fines established pursuant to section 1-10(j) of the Code of Ordinances.

(3) An informal notice of dispute may be filed with the city within seven (7) days of the occurrence of the violation and shall immediately postpone payment. Receipt of this notice of dispute within seven (7) days means that only the lowest fine for each violation as indicated in section 1-10(j) of the Code of Ordinances shall be imposed if payment is made within five (5) days of the date of a notice to the defendant that the notice of dispute is not justified. If full payment is not received within five (5) days, the fines shall increase as indicated in section 1-10(j) of the Code of Ordinances as though the notice of dispute was never received. Notices of dispute must be written and filed with the municipal collector's office at 400 South Vine Street in Urbana, Illinois.

(5) If neither full payment nor a notice of dispute is received within seven (7) days following the violation and no other action has been taken by the parking violator, the fine imposed upon the parking violator shall increase according to section 23-211(a)(2).

**ARTICLE XVII
PARKING METERS**

Sec. 23-236. Parking in unmetered spaces in municipal parking lots and metered streets prohibited.

No person shall park a motor vehicle in an unmetered space in the municipal parking lots or in an unmetered space on any street, or portion thereof, that has been designated as a metered area.

Sec. 23-248. Unauthorized use of rental spaces.

Subsection (c) deleted

Sec. 23-249. Unauthorized parking, permit only lot.

Subsection (b) deleted

Sec. 23-265. Expired registration plates/no registration plates.

Any motor vehicle which would be required to have motor vehicle registration plates under the laws of the State of Illinois to be operated upon the public highways, must display registration plates issued by the State of Illinois or another state which are valid and unexpired at all times when such vehicle is on a public street in the City of Urbana, or in a parking lot owned by the city of Urbana.

Subsection (b) deleted

Secs. 23-266-23-270. Reserved.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
