ORDINANCE NO. 2011-11-126

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE
ESTABLISHING SPEED REGULATIONS ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Prairie Winds Drive; Prairie Winds Circle)

WHEREAS, it has been found that the Urbana Local Traffic Code has no provisions to decrease speed limits on City streets below the statutory state speed limit and no Schedule for listing said streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Article V entitled "Speed Regulations" of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING the following Section 23-64 entitled "Decreasing State Speed Limits on Certain Streets":

"Sec. 23-64. Decreasing state speed limits on certain streets.

It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the maximum speed permitted by state law upon the following streets, described hereto and made a part hereof, is greater than is reasonable or safe with respect to the conditions found to exist at any place or along any part or zone of such street. It is hereby declared that the maximum speed limit shall be hereinafter set forth but not lower than the minimum limits as prescribed by state law on those streets or parts of streets herein designated when signs are erected giving notice thereof, all as set forth in Schedule Q."

SECTION 2: That Schedule Q of Section 23-64 entitled "Decreasing state speed limits", of the Urbana Local Traffic Code is hereby amended by ADDING to that Schedule the following speed regulations for the following streets or portions thereof:

Prairie Winds Drive	Colorado Avenue	Prairie Winds Circle	25 MPH
Prairie Winds Circle	Prairie Winds Drive	Prairie Winds Drive	25 MPH

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
