

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08-068

**AN ORDINANCE NAMING A STREET, AVENUE, ALLEY,  
OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACE**

**(Boneyard Creek Crossing)**

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-80-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-19) provides that the corporate authorities of each municipality may name originally and then change the name of any street, avenue, alley, or other public place; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Urbana ("City") has undertaken a project known as the Boneyard Creek Improvements Project to beautify the primary public waterway that runs through the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City heretofore has not designated an official name for the land adjoining the Boneyard Creek; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, after due consideration, finds that the best interests of the City are served by naming a certain portion of such adjoining land the "Boneyard Creek Crossing," as provided herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the requirements of Section 11-80-19 for notice to the election authorities having jurisdiction in the area and to the post office branch serving that area apply to a change in the name of a public place but do not apply to the original naming of a public place.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.**

The public land adjoining the Boneyard Creek located between West Griggs Street and North Broadway Avenue, further described as being situated within Segment 3 of the City of Urbana Boneyard Creek Master Plan, dated May 2008, be and is hereby named "Boneyard Creek Crossing," as depicted in Exhibit "A,"

which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2.**

The appropriate records of the City, including all maps which are part of the City's 2005 Comprehensive Plan, shall be adjusted accordingly to reflect the new name.

**Section 3.**

The proper officers, employees, and agents of the City are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to do all such acts and things and to execute and deliver all documents and instruments as may be necessary to carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance in accordance with its terms.

**Section 4.**

This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

**Section 5.**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the corporate authorities (5 of 8 votes) of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a meeting of said corporate authorities.

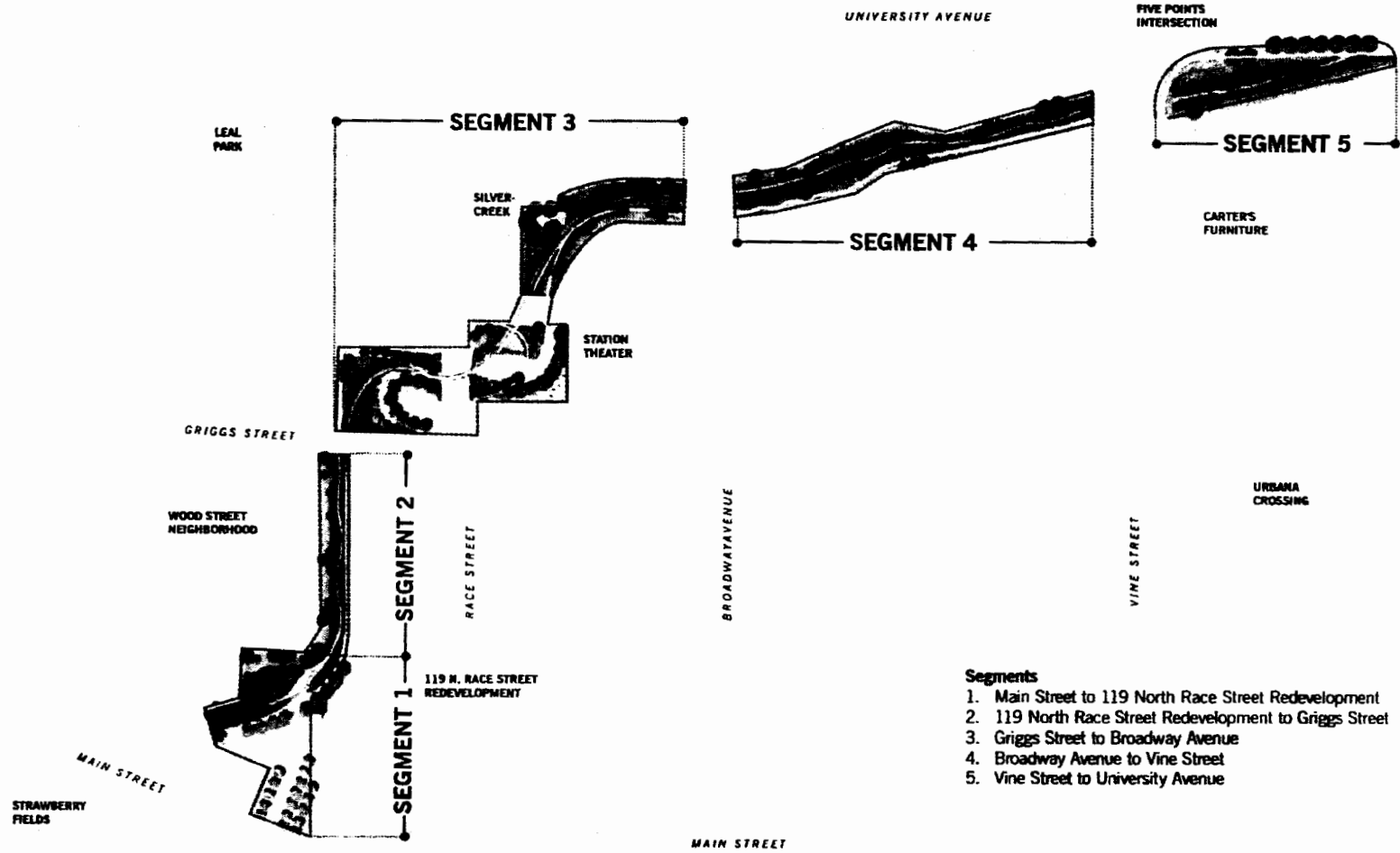
