

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-10-102

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 23-183 OF THE  
URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL  
TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

(Bradley Avenue between Lincoln Avenue and Western City Limits of Urbana)

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana (hereinafter, the "City"), an Illinois municipal corporation (the "City") and a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article 7, § 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and 65 ILCS 5/1-1-10; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted and has the authority to amend or modify its local traffic code which is set forth in the Urbana City Code as Section 23.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, pursuant to the aforesaid traffic code, has the authority to regulate parking on its streets and in its parking lots; and

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana restricts parking on streets to provide public safety and access.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of Section 23-183, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times on Certain Streets" of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following portions of streets where no person shall be permitted to park a vehicle at any time:

Bradley Avenue	From 134 feet west of the centerline of Carver Drive to 164 feet east of the centerline of Mathews Avenue	South Side

Bradley Avenue                      From 167 feet west of                      South Side

Avenue to the centerline  
of Lincoln Avenue

Bradley Avenue                      From 162 feet west of                      North Side  
the centerline of Goodwin  
Avenue to the centerline  
of Lincoln Avenue

**Section 2.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a meeting of said Council.
