WHEREAS, the Postal Department of the United States, have planned to build an addition to the Post Office in Urbana, Illinois, and

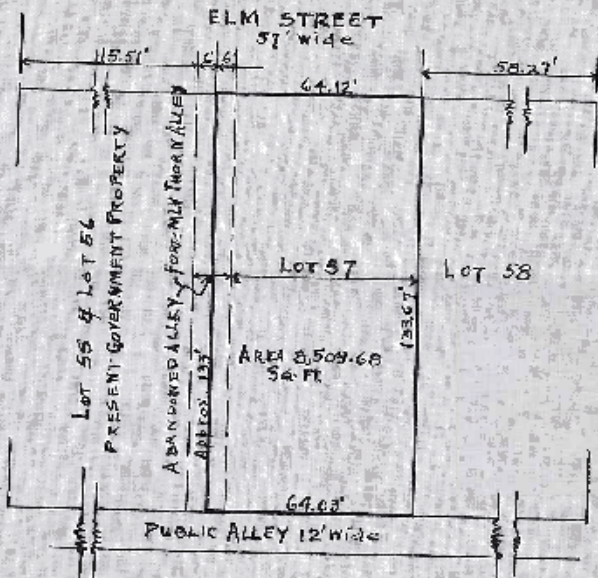
WHEREAS, to secure the necessary property for the same, condemnation proceedings were had in the Federal Court, at Danville, Illinois, and

Whereas, in completing the abstract of title to said tract of ground showing title in the United States Government it is necessary for a transcript of said proceedings to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, there appears in said transcript a Plat of said Ground, so condemned, which does not conflict with existing plats of record, and which has not been approved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, within whose boundaries said land lies.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by this council, of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said plat be and the same is hereby approved, this 21st day of January A. D. 1935.
