

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LETTING OF A CONTRACT FOR  
CONSTRUCTION OF MUNICIPAL HALL AND RECREATION  
CENTER WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS.

Whereas it is provided in Section 58 - 1 Chapter 24,  
Smith - Hurd Illinois Revised Statutes of 1941, that a contract  
for public improvement exceeding the cost of \$500.00 may be let  
by the proper officers of a municipality without advertising for  
bids, if authorized by a vote of two-thirds of all the alderman  
elected; Now therefore-

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS;

That the advertisement for bids for the construction of  
a Municipal Hall and Recreation Center for the City of Urbana be  
dispensed with, pursuant to the vote of more than two-thirds of  
the alderman elected in said City, and that the Mayor and City  
Clerk of said City be and they are hereby authorized to enter into  
contract for said City with any responsible contractor for the con-  
struction of said building whom the Mayor and Architect for said  
building shall select with the advice and approval of the Defense  
Public Works Division of the Federal Works Agency.
