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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, BY CHANGING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARY LINES AND RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM "B" MULTIPLE DWELLING AND APARTMENT DISTRICT, TO "C" LOCAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, has heretofore, by resolution, ordered and directed the Board of Appeals under the Zoning Ordinance of said City, to call a public hearing for the purpose of hearing any persons desiring to be heard upon the question of rezoning the lot and parcel of land described as the East 55 feet of Lot 4 in Block 41 in the Seminary Addition to Urbana, changing the boundary lines under the Zoning Ordinance and reclassifying said property from "B" Multiple Dwelling and Apartment District to "C" Local Commercial District, and

WHEREAS, said Board of Appeals met in public hearing on June 11, 1947, pursuant to notice duly given by publication in the Champaign-Urbana Courier, a newspaper regularly published in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that a notice of said public hearing set forth the time and place for said public hearing, and that no property owners appeared before said Board at said public hearing to object to the rezoning of said premises; that pursuant to said public hearing, the Board of Appeals under the Zoning Ordinance has unanimously recommended to the City Council the rezoning of the above described property changing the same from "B" Multiple Dwelling and Apartment District to "C" Local Commercial District:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be amended and that the district boundary lines be changed and the property described as the East 55 feet of Lot 4 in Block 41 in the Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana,


be reclassified from "B" Multiple Dwelling and Apartment

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON A PORTION OF  
GREEN STREET, GOODWIN AVENUE, ILLINOIS STREET,  
RACE STREET AND BROADWAY STREET

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That hereafter no automobile or vehicle shall be parked on either side of Green Street between Matthews Avenue and Goodwin Avenue.

SECTION 2. No car or vehicle shall be parked on the east side of Goodwin Avenue between Green Street and Illinois Street. No car or vehicle shall park longer than 30 minutes in any two hour period on the east side of Goodwin Avenue between Illinois Street and California Street.

SECTION 3. No car or vehicle shall be parked on the south side of Illinois Street between Goodwin Avenue and Matthews Avenue.

SECTION 4. No car or vehicle shall be parked on the west side of Race Street between Washington Street and Iowa Street.

SECTION 5. No car or vehicle shall be parked on the east side of Broadway between Elm Street and a point 30 feet south thereof in order to permit access to the mailing box on the corner of Broadway and Elm Street. No car or vehicle shall be parked on the east side of Broadway Street longer than 15 minutes in any two hour period between the point 30 feet south of Elm Street and the alley extending east and west on the south side of the Post Office property.

No car or vehicle shall be parked on the west side of Broadway Street for longer period than 15 minutes in any two hour period between Elm Street and extending south for a space equal to 5 parking spaces, which spaces shall be marked off by the City for such purposes.


SECTION 6. The City Marshal shall cause four-way "Slow" signs to be erected at the corner of Oregon Street and Goodwin Avenue, so that traffic over both Oregon Street and Goodwin Avenue shall slow down at said intersection.

The City Marshal shall also cause appropriate signs to be erected to regulate the traffic upon the streets at the points designated by this ordinance.
