

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of May A. D., 1950, WILLIAM B. WEBBER and MAUDE M. WEBBER, his wife; and PEARL WEBBER, a spinster; and HENRY I. GREEN and ELSIE M. GREEN, his wife, executed a written instrument dedicating to the Township of Urbana, for public road purposes, the following extensions of Urbana streets, towit:


R E S O L U T I O N
