

R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana, Illinois favor House Bill No. 867 which is now being considered by the Committee on Motor Vehicles and Traffic Regulations in the House of Representatives in Springfield, Illinois. This proposed legislation provides that whenever the proper local authorities enact suitable legislation to legalize the use of self-illuminated flashing signals designated as "school crossing stop signals" and to require traffic to obey such signals, and whenever the proper school authorities communicate in writing to the Department their agreement to provide a trained safety patrol as a supplement to such signals, the Department shall erect, maintain, and operate such signals at an appropriate place on any State highway which must be crossed by the pupils attending such school.

Be it further resolved that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the local members of the legislature and the Illinois State Senator from this district.
