

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Pearl Webber, W. B. Webber and Maude Webber, his wife, have, by written instrument, dedicated to the public for street and highway purposes, an extension of Pennsylvania Avenue from Vine Street to Anderson Street in said City; and

Whereas, a portion of the land being so dedicated is located within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the balance of said land being located within one and one-half (1½) miles of said City; and


Whereas, such dedication as hereinafter described conforms with the Master Plan adopted by the City of Urbana, and such dedication appears to be for the best interests of the people of said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE DEDICATION for street and road purposes of Pearl Webber, W. B. Webber and Maude Webber, of the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of Section Seventeen (17) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third Principal Meridian in Champaign County, Illinois, going thence West on the South line of Section Seventeen (17) Five feet (5'), thence Northerly a distance of Eight Hundred Thirty-six and Four Tenths feet (836.4') to a point being at where the West line of Anderson Street intersects with the North line of Lot Five (5) of William B. and Pearl Webber's Anderson Street Addition as a point of beginning, thence Westerly a distance of One Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-two and Eighty-nine Hundredths feet (1,282.89') to a point at the East line of Vine Street and being Eight Hundred Thirty-six and Four Tenths feet (836.4') North of the point where the east line of Vine Street intersects with the South line of Section Seventeen (17), thence North along the East line of Vine Street Eighty feet (80'), thence Easterly and parallel to the first described line to the West line of Anderson Street, thence South along the West line of Anderson Street Eighty feet (80') to the point of beginning, and all situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois,

be, and the same is hereby accepted and approved by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the same is ordered to be recorded.


RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did on October 15, 1951, authorize the purchase of a Dodge Street Truck to be paid for out of the Garbage Disposal Fund with money later to be reimbursed to the Garbage Disposal Fund from the Rental Equipment Fund; and

WHEREAS, it appears said Garbage Disposal Fund contains sufficient money to pay all obligations which may be legally charged against said Fund during the current fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS: - That the obligation of \$2,143.59 due to the Garbage Disposal Fund from the Rental Equipment Fund as shown on the annual audit of the City of Urbana for the fiscal year ending on April 30, 1952, be cancelled.
