

RESOLUTION CONCERNING DEFENSE OF
ILLINOIS POWER COMPANY RATE CASE


WHEREAS, application has been made to the Illinois Commerce Commission on behalf of the Illinois Power Company for an increase in electric, gas and steam heating rates to be charged by said public utility in this City, and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Urbana has previously authorized the expenditure of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) in defense of such application, and

Whereas, it has been recommended to the City Council that said sum be made available for a joint defense on the part of the cities of Champaign, Urbana, Decatur, Danville and the University of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City of Urbana contribute the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00) towards a joint defense of said rate proceeding and that said amount be paid for legal services and expenses of any attorney who may be employed by such cities for such work.
