

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors of Champaign County, Illinois, did on the 10th day of February, A. D. 1954, adopt a Resolution authorizing the transfer of the hereinafter described real estate to the City of Urbana, Illinois for street purposes, and

Whereas, pursuant to said Resolution, C. C. Haworth, as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and Harry A. Little, as County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois, have executed a Quit-Claim Deed conveying to the City of Urbana, the real estate described as follows, to-wit:


Commencing at a point on the South line of Main Street and on the West line of Bennett Avenue Fifty-one feet (51') West of the Northwest corner of Lot Twenty-one (21) of the Original Town of Urbana, thence West Eight feet (8'), thence South on a line parallel to the West line of said Lot Twenty-one (21) to a point Fifty-eight feet (58') North of the North line of Lot Sixty-one (61) and Fifty-nine feet (59') West of the West line of Lot Sixty-three (63) of said Original Town of Urbana, thence West to a point on the East line of Broadway Avenue in said City of Urbana Fifty-eight feet (58') North of the Northwest corner of Lot Fifty-five (55) of the Original Town of Urbana, thence South Eight feet (8'), thence East along the North line of Elm Street to a point which is located Fifty feet (50') North of Lot Sixty-one (61) and Fifty-one feet (51') West of Lot Sixty-three (63) of the Original Town of Urbana, thence North to the place of beginning, all situated in the County of Champaign and State of Illinois, and

Whereas, said Deed was authorized and executed on the express condition that the City of Urbana shall not install parking meters on any of the above described real estate without the installation of such meters having been first approved by the County Board of Supervisors of Champaign County, Illinois:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that the Quit-Claim Deed above mentioned from the County of Champaign to the City of Urbana, dated February 27, 1954, is hereby accepted by the City of Urbana with the restriction contained therein to the effect that the City of Urbana shall not install parking meters on any of the above real estate without the installation of such meters having been first approved by the County Board of Champaign County, Illinois.

Be it Further Resolved that the City Clerk of the City of Urbana
is hereby authorized and directed to record said Deed in the Recorder's
Office of the County of Champaign and State of Illinois.
