

RESOLUTION CONCERNING BLOCKADE OF BERKLEY AVENUE

FOR SCHOOL CROSSING PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools of School District No. 116 has requested permission of the City Council to blockade the portion of Berkley Avenue East of Washington School for certain periods during each school day to permit the students at said school to cross said street safely, from the school grounds to the play area East of Berkley Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Alderman are of the opinion that the temporary blockading of said street for such periods would be a reasonable exercise of the police powers of said City to promote the safety and welfare

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that School District No. 116 be permitted to place blockades *marked "School Crossing, Proceed with Caution"* on Berkley Avenue East of the Washington School Grounds on days when school is in session at the following times, to-wit:

8:30 A.M.	to	8:55 A.M.,
10:30 A.M.	to	11:00 A.M.,
12:30 P.M.	to	1:10 P.M., and
2:30 P.M.	to	3:00 P.M.

Provided, however, that said School District shall assume responsibility for the safety of the children crossing the street during the time the blockades are in place, and will hold the City harmless from any accident which might occur during said periods, and provided further that said School District shall place and remove the blockades at the beginning and end of each period mentioned above.
