


RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that the ordinance for the Lincoln Avenue and Nevada Street Widening and Resurfacing Improvement No. 250-74Cs, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, which has been presented to the City Council this 18th day of April, A. D. 1955, be filed on this date with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana for public inspection and that same be published in the Champaign-Urbana Courier more than ten (10) days prior to ~~May 2nd, 1955~~ <sup>April 30, 1955</sup>, and that the same be referred to the Ordinance Committee to be presented to the City Council for final passage on ~~May 2, 1955~~ <sup>April 30, 1955</sup>.


WHEREAS, it appears that there is an insufficient amount of money in the General Corporate Fund of the City of Urbana to pay all of the salaries and expenses normally chargeable to said fund for the balance of the fiscal year ending April 30, 1955; and

WHEREAS, the Public Comfort Station Fund of said City has a surplus of in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) which said surplus is not needed for purposes connected with the Public Comfort Station of the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, it is considered an unwise policy to resort to borrowing on anticipation warrants, in that interest must be paid when such borrowing occurs.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that the City Clerk and City Treasurer be authorized to transfer from the Public Comfort Station Fund into the General Corporate Fund, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), which said amount shall be repaid to said Public Comfort Station Fund when such repayment can be made without depleting the General Corporate Fund below the amount necessary for the proper administration of the fiscal policies of the City, and when such repayment is ordered by resolution of the City Council.
