


RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL CONCERNING

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that the City Attorney be directed to file suit in the Circuit Court of Champaign County, Illinois for a temporary and permanent injunction against HAROLD R. LAMEDIN of 705 West Stoughton Street, Urbana, Illinois, to restrain further construction of a building in violation of the Zoning Ordinance, Building Code, and a portion of which building is being built in the street.


