

RESOLUTION FOR DESTRUCTION OF UNSOLD LOCAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

WHEREAS, it is desirable that said bonds be destroyed,


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:
