RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is now pending before the Illinois Commerce Commission a Petition of the Illinois Power Company, in which said Petitioner requests an increase in the rates it now charges for electric service in the areas they serve.

AND WHEREAS, the examination of the basis for a rate structure is a highly complicated study, requiring the skill of accountants and engineers, we recognize that we are not in a position to evaluate the justness of the requests contained in the Petition.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that the Mayor and other City Authorities of said City respectfully request the Commission to assign an adequate number of its very capable and able staff to the examination of the petition, and that it be studied with the greatest care, before any recommendations for rate increases be made or granted, in accordance therewith; and further requests that if the Commission should find that rate increases are absolutely necessary, that they be kept at a minimum, consistent with the findings of the Commission.
