

RESOLUTION FOR USE OF PUBLIC ALLEY

WHEREAS, the platted alley heretofore dedicated and used as a public alley between Race Street and Broadway Avenue, from Main Street to Goose Alley, in the City of Urbana, Illinois, is narrow, ~~bordered~~ ^{bordered} with business buildings, and is so located and is in such condition and circumstances that the best public use of said alley or portion of alley should be to eliminate vehicular traffic, and devote the alley described and located as aforesaid to pedestrian traffic only, and incidental uses for pedestrians and the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

With reference to the use of said alley, the City Council herewith determines to eliminate vehicular traffic and devote the alley, described and located as aforesaid, to pedestrian traffic only, with facilities, decorations, and features for public use of all pedestrians and the public generally.
