AMENDED RESOLUTION IN REFERENCE TO PREVAILING WAGES

WHEREAS, Illinois Revised Statutes, Chapter 48, 39s-1, 39s-12, Prevailing Wage Law, as amended August 8, 1961, requires that the public body awarding any contract for public work or doing the work by day labor shall ascertain the general prevailing hourly rate of wages for employees engaged on such work, and,

WHEREAS, the Statutes further provide that said rates of pay be publicly posted and/or kept available for inspection by any interested party and a certified copy thereof promptly filed in the office of the Secretary of State.

That pursuant to the requirements of Section 2, 3 and 4 of "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," as enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois with amendments thereto through 1961, the City Council of the City of Urbana does hereby ascertain and determine that the prevailing rate of per hour wages for all new contract work performed under the supervision and direction of said City, or any officer or employee acting in behalf of said City, and for any new construction contract work or repair work done under contract to which the City or any officer or employee acting in behalf of said City is a party and paid for in whole or in part of the funds of said City, shall be as follows:

Eight hours shall constitute a day and the rate for overtime shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay, and for work on Sundays and Legal Holidays, the rate shall be double the regular rate of pay; provided, however, that the rate of pay on Saturdays for concrete finishers, common labor, truck drivers, and helpers shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply to the prevailing hourly rate of wages in the locality for employment other than public works construction as defined in the Act, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Secretary of State.
