

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING QUIT CLAIM DEED


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the Mayor and City Clerk of said City are hereby authorized to make, execute, and deliver a quit claim deed to the First Baptist Church, of Urbana, Illinois, a religious corporation, to a tract of real estate described and bounded as follows:

X Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot Twenty-Two (22) of James T. Roe's Third Addition to Urbana, Illinois; Thence north along the west right-of-way line of Race Street 12 feet to the southeast corner of Lot Seven (7) of said Addition; thence westerly along the south lines of Lots Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), and Ten (10) of said Addition to the southwest corner of said Lot Ten (10); thence south to the northwest corner of the east one-third ($E\frac{1}{3}$) of Lot Twenty-One (21), thence easterly along the north lines of said Lots Twenty-One (21) and Twenty-Two (22) to the northeast corner of said Lot Twenty-Two (22), the point of beginning; with the exception from said described tract, the East Eleven and One-Half ($E-11\frac{1}{2}$) feet of the tract.

All situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, and State of Illinois. X


RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OFF-STREET PARKING
COMMISSION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND
TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the Off-Street Parking Commission of said City is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and proposals for construction of off-street parking areas and surfaces, and to include preparation of the areas and to equip such off-street parking lots, in Central Business Addition of the City of Urbana, Illinois, in conjunction with the Lincoln Square project, and in and about Block 36 of Seminary Addition in the City of Urbana, Illinois, and on Lot One except the east 22 feet thereof, and all of Lot Two of James T. Roe's Second Addition to Urbana; all situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, and State of Illinois.

The said Commission is further authorized to advertise for bids and proposals, enter into necessary contracts for such construction on said parking lot areas, and the Commission is further authorized to perform all acts and transactions incidental to the proper construction and completion of said projects.
