

RESOLUTION IN REGARD TO PREVAILING WAGES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:


That pursuant to the requirements of Sections 2, 3 and 4 of "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," as enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois with amendments thereto through 1961, the City Council of the City of Urbana does hereby ascertain and determine that the prevailing rate of per hour wages for all new construction contract work performed under the supervision and direction of the City, or any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City, and for any new construction contract work or repair work done under contract to which the City of any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City is a party and paid for in whole or in part of the funds of the City, shall be as follows:

Eight hours shall constitute a day and the rate for overtime shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay, and for work on Sundays and legal holidays, the rate shall be double the regular rate of pay; provided, however, that the rate of pay on Saturdays for concrete finishers, common labor, truck drivers and helpers shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay.
