RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That the remains of the main house and the smaller two-room house and the barn and sheds on the tract of real estate at the address of 711 North Cunningham Avenue, also formerly known as 709, having been inspected by the City Engineer, Fire Inspector, and an appraiser, and having been found by them to be in a very dangerous, dilapidated and crumbly condition and a fire hazard and a hazard to children, that the City Council hereby finds them to be in such condition and dangerous and such hazards to the public, and that the value of the tract is less than without the structures, the City Council further hereby condemns these structures and authorizes fire protection funds and other City funds and resources to be employed in the demolition of the structures forthwith, and further to attempt to get consent from owners and from any courts with jurisdictions in regard to the tract and structures; and authorize establishment of a charge or lien on the tract and proceeds of any sale of the tract for reimbursement of the cost of demolition.
