

RESOLUTION IN REGARD TO PREVAILING WAGES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

That pursuant to the requirements of Sections 2, 3 and 4 of "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," as enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois with amendments thereto through 1963, the City Council of the City of Urbana does hereby ascertain and determine that the "prevailing rate of wages" for all new construction contract work performed under the supervision and direction of the City, or any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City, and for any new construction contract work or repair work done under contract to which the City or any officer or employee acting in behalf of the City is a party and paid for in whole or in part with funds of the City, shall be as follows:

Eight hours shall constitute a regular workday and 40 hours shall constitute a regular work week.

The hourly rate for overtime work for the various classifications shall be as follows:

The overtime rate for Painters and Truck drivers and helpers shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay. The overtime rate for Glaziers, Tile and Marble Setter helpers and Operating engineers, Head Concrete finishers, Concrete finishers and Laborers on Highway and heavy construction work shall be one and one-half times the regular rate of pay except that the overtime rate for Sundays and Holidays shall be double the regular rate of pay. The overtime rate for all other classifications shall be double the regular rate of pay.
