

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, our City has lost many beautiful trees in recent years as a result of disease and ice storms, and

WHEREAS, it is essential to restore and maintain arboreal beauty in our City, and

WHEREAS, the CCDC Foundation has led a program of planting Centennial Trees along University Avenue, in which program our City, many of its individual citizens, business firms, organizations, and the University of Illinois have cooperated to commemorate in a lasting manner the centennial of the University,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Urbana commends the CCDC Foundation for its leadership of the Centennial Trees program, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Works are authorized and directed to take appropriate steps, including the utilization of city employees, to insure that said Centennial Trees are at all times properly watered and otherwise cared for, and be it further

RESOLVED, that these trees and the memorial plaques related to certain of them be protected against damage, in perpetuity, by the full force of all appropriate laws of the City of Urbana.
