

A RESOLUTION

CONCERNING PASSENGER SERVICE OF THE ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD

WHEREAS, the Illinois Central Railroad provides essential passenger to the Urbana-Champaign community, and

WHEREAS, service has been deteriorating, to wit: dirty coaches, trains not stopping in the station, undependable schedules, inadequate dining facilities, reduction of other services, and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Central Railroad proposes the discontinuance of passenger trains number 3 and 4 between Chicago and Memphis,

THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, petitions the Illinois Central Railroad to provide the quality of passenger service essential to the continued growth of our progressive community, and

THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, implores the Illinois Central Railroad to restore the quality of passenger service to that provided as recently as ten years ago, and


THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, petitions the Illinois Commerce Commission and the Interstate Commerce Commission to investigate this rapidly deteriorating service and to use all of their persuasive and legal powers to restore high quality passenger service for the Urbana-Champaign area, and

FURTHERMORE, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, petitions the Interstate Commerce Commission to disallow discontinuance of trains 3 and 4.
