

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has received a report from Clark Deitz & Associates, advising that a certain bridge located near the east entrance to Crystal Lake Park, on North Broadway, sometimes called The Saline Branch Bridge, is unsafe and,


WHEREAS, the above said Engineers recommended certain immediate action be instituted to protect the public, and

WHEREAS, due to the emergency nature of the matter, the Commissioner of Public Works took certain steps, to-wit:

- 1 - To limit the vehicular traffic to a maximum truck load of 6 tons.
- 2 - To close to traffic the outer 5 1/2 feet wide strips of pavement, thus limiting the traffic to one way flow, on a 16 foot wide single lane only.
- 3 - To take the measures necessary to close off the underside of the bridge to all unauthorized personnel.

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Urbana herewith and hereby ratifies the above actions taken by The Commissioner of Public Works and directs that such restrictions and actions continue with regard to the bridge in question on North Broadway sometimes called Saline Branch Bridge until such time as such bridge is again made safe for the public.
