

RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the amount of pedestrian traffic, both along and crossing West Green Street between Wright Street and Lincoln Avenue, has increased over the past years, and,

WHEREAS, due to the increase in pedestrian traffic, as aforesaid, the City Council deems it advisable to study the situation with regard to the safety of both pedestrians and automobile traffic traveling along and upon Green Street;


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

The Mayor of the City of Urbana is authorized to enter into a contract with Clark, Dietz and Associates, Consulting Engineers, for an amount not to exceed \$7,000.00, the purpose of said contract being to study the traffic pattern and situation as it exists in the aforementioned area and to propose solutions therefore, provided, however, that no contract shall be entered into by the Mayor, as aforesaid, unless the University of Illinois enters into an Agreement whereby the University of Illinois shall pay approximately 85% of the actual cost of such contract with Clark, Dietz and Associates.
