WHEREAS, environmental pollution is a problem facing all Americans and it is a problem which must be dealt with now, and


WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Illinois has responded to the problem by enacting the Anti-Pollution Bond Act, a proposition which must be accepted by the voters in a referendum in the November election and passage of this referendum would authorize the financing of a \$750 million bond issue to plan, finance and construct city sewage treatment works and facilities for solid waste disposal, two critical areas of the pollution problem, and

WHEREAS, this is an opportunity for Illinois residents to support the fight against pollution and actively participate in a specific anti-pollution program through contribution of tax dollars, and


WHEREAS, the pollution of our environment will not end unless each person is willing to support innovative anti-pollution measures,
