

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MASS TRANSIT DISTRICT REFERENDUM


WHEREAS the voters will be asked to decide on November 24, 1970, whether or not a mass transit district shall be created in the Champaign-Urbana area, and

WHEREAS a majority of votes cast against the creation of a mass transit district shall result in the cessation of bus service in the Champaign-Urbana area, and


WHEREAS this City Council deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Urbana that mass transit be maintained and improved in our community, and the creation of a Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District is the best available solution,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Urbana City Council recommends the approval of the Mass Transit District Referendum.
