

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Local Improvements has proposed making a local improvement project known as Golfview Sewer Project, and

1. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to file a Petition on behalf of the City of Urbana under the provisions of Article 9, Chapter 24, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1969;
