commonly known as 1210 W. Hill, Urbana, Illinois, and



WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice together with a copy of the said Ordinance was duly mailed to Clark T. Henson at 707 Hessel, Champaign, Illinois, on April 9, 1971, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and


WHEREAS, he has apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.
