

RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT BY MUNICIPALITY UNDER THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois

that the following described street(s) be improved under the Illinois Highway Code:

Table with 4 columns: Name of Thoroughfare, Arterial Street or Route, From, To. Row 1: University Avenue, Various intersections, Vine Street, Wright Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

1. That the proposed improvement consist of new signal equipment consisting of posts and mast arms, with 12-inch signals, a skid resistant over lay at intersections, synchronized signals, and preemption equipment; and engineering

construction feet wide and shall be designated as Section 179 C.S.

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of thirty thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$30,000.00) for the improvement of said section from the municipality's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.

3. That said work shall be done by Contract; and, (Specify Contract or Day Labor)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby directed to transmit two certified copies of this resolution to the Department of Public Works and Buildings, Division of Highways, through its District Engineer.
