commonly known as 1311 West Eads, Urbana, Illinois, and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Andrew T. Henson and Maxine H. Turner are the record owners of the said premises, and

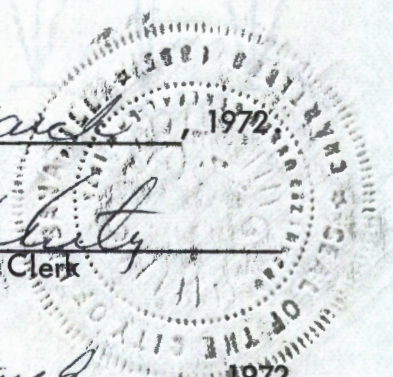

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.


