commonly known as 606 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois, and


WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Busey First National Bank, Trustee under Trust #206, is the record owner of the said premises, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owner, Busey First National Bank, 201 West Main Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801 on February 11, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.


