WHEREAS, it appears from public records that The First National Bank of Peoria, Trustee under Trust No. 1454, is the record owner of the said premises, and

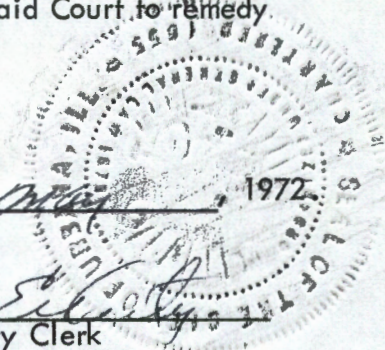
WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owner, The First National Bank of Peoria, 416 Main Street, Peoria, Illinois on March 8, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
