

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the two structures on the North side of the following described premises were inspected by Larry E. Reed and found to be dangerous buildings:

Lot 4 of Barr and Ford's Subdivision of Lot 12 of a Subdivision of the W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 9 and part of Lot 17 of a Subdivision of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 8 in Twp. 19 N.R. 9 East of the 3rd P.M., except that part deeded to the State of Illinois, for right-of-way purposes, situated in the City of Urbana, in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 1008 North Cunningham, Urbana, Illinois (formerly 808 North Cunningham), and

WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Champaign County Bank And Trust Co. is the record owner of the said premises, and

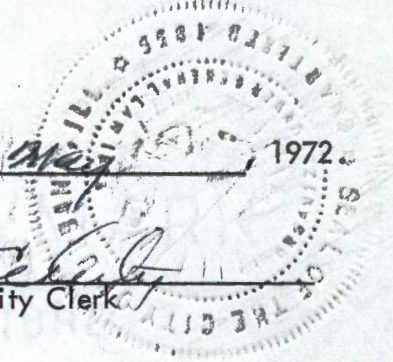
WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice, together with a copy of the said Ordinance, was duly mailed to the record owner, Champaign County Bank And Trust Co., 102 East Main Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801 on March 8, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and

WHEREAS, they have apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that the City Attorney be directed to file the necessary complaints in the Circuit Court of Champaign County to invoke the jurisdiction of the said Court to remedy the situation.
