

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

that:

(1) The investigation division of the Urbana Police Force shall consist of one (1) lieutenant and four (4) patrolmen. The position of sergeant shall be eliminated.

(2) The department head shall assign a lieutenant from the regular line lieutenants to the duty of investigation division.


(3) The patrolmen investigators shall be assigned from among the line patrolmen with no change in civil service position resulting from doing investigative work.

(4) A pool of qualified patrolmen for investigator positions shall be established by means of a qualifying examination open to all patrolmen with at least two (2) years service. Such examination shall be conducted by the civil service commission on a pass-fail basis.

(5) Police training institute courses on criminal investigation or their equivalent shall be required of each person assigned to an investigative position, and shall be provided at city expense.


(6) Assigned investigators should receive an additional \$25.00 monthly clothing allowance.
