commonly known as 1101 N. Gregory, Urbana, Illinois, and



WHEREAS, it appears from public records that Max L. Henson and M. Joanne Henson are the record owners of the said premises, subject to a mortgage to Urbana Home Loan Association, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Urbana City Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Dangerous Buildings", a notice together with a copy of the said Ordinance was duly mailed to the record owner, Max L. Henson, 206 Henson Road, Villa Grove, Illinois, on May 23, 1972, commanding that the situation be remedied immediately, and there being no occupant, and


WHEREAS, he has apparently wholly neglected or refused to remedy the situation.
