



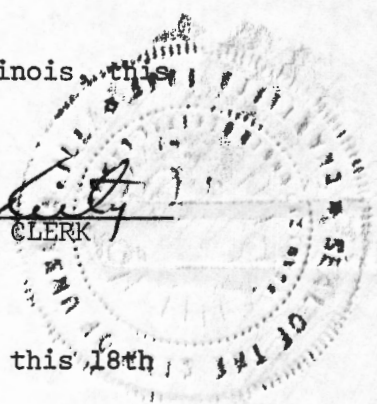
WHEREAS, it has become a matter of national concern that there are members of the Armed Forces of the United States that are Prisoners of War and/or Missing in Action; and

WHEREAS, it has become a matter of concern of the Champaign-Urbana community;


