RESOLUTION FOR LOW COST HOUSING  
IN URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, there is a continued shortage of housing in the City of Urbana; and

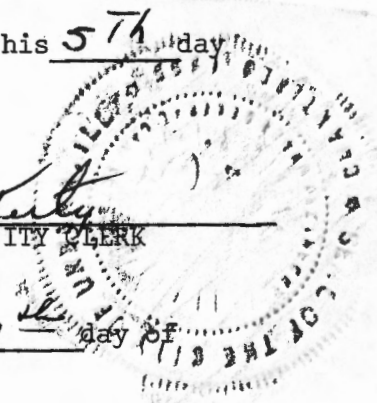
WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of Champaign County is charged with the responsibility of providing low cost and elderly housing in Champaign County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That we reaffirm our request made in a Resolution for Low Cost Housing, dated March 2, 1970, that the Champaign County Housing Authority get authorization for the construction of 300 units of housing in the City of Urbana, 40% of which to be low income housing, and 60% of the total to be housing for the elderly, and that the locations of these new housing units be developed on scattered sites in the City of Urbana, and that the family housing be limited to no more than 40 units per site.
