


RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, by the latest Federal census, the CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, has a population well in excess of 25,000 persons, and

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that any municipality which has a population of more than 25,000 are Home Rule units,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that all actions taken from this date forward, and also including actions previously taken by the Urbana City Council since July 1, 1971, shall be, and hereby are declared to be, in the proper exercise of the powers of a Home Rule unit as such powers are defined in Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.


